

# NJR Consultant Level Reports and Surgeon Level Reports 2021

NJR Consultant Level Reports (CLRs) and Surgeon Level Reports (SLRs) for 2021 will be available week commencing **19th July** for download from the NJR Connect - Data Services platform. We will send you a notification email once they are ready for you to download. You are encouraged to download your report and to use this as part of your appraisal.

**This year there are a number of changes to the reports, outlined below.**

***For all joints recorded activity in both the SLR and CLR:***

- DAIR without modular exchange procedures have been removed from the three-year volumes of procedure type graph and placed in a separate table.

***For Hip revision in both the SLR and CLR:***

- There is a new table showing conversion of hemi-arthroplasties. This table is a subset of the Linked/Attributable revision table and shows revisions of primary hip replacements where the primary procedure was either of the following:
  - ***MDSv7:***
    - Conversion of Hemi Arthroplasty to Total Primary Hip Replacement
    - Conversion of Hemi Arthroplasty to Total Primary Hip Replacement Retaining Femoral Stem.
  - ***Or Pre-MDSv7:***
    - Where the Indication of Implantation was 'Failed Hemi-Arthroplasty'

***For Hip joints implant usage in both the SLR and CLR:***

- Use of ODEP rated implants - the ODEP rating shown is that at the time the procedure took place. There is a new table - implant brand usage in primary hip replacement - which shows the average number of brands used in primary hip replacement procedures by the surgeon, compared to the average for all surgeons in the registry for the latest five years. The number of procedures for this time period is also shown.

***For Knee joints implant usage in both the SLR and CLR:***

- There is a new section which is comprised of two parts:

- Use of ODEP rated constructs - consists of a bar chart and accompanying table showing use of ODEP rated constructs over the latest 12 months. The ODEP rating shown is that at the time the procedure took place.
- Implant brand usage in primary knee replacement - shows the average number of brands used in primary knee replacement procedures by the surgeon compared to the average for all surgeons in the NJR for the latest five years.  
The number of procedures for the time period is also shown.

***For Knee joints recorded activity in both the SLR and CLR:***

- Multicompartmental knee replacements have been added to the graph showing the three-year volumes of procedure types.
- There is a new table showing the number of primary unicondylar knees undertaken by the surgeon in the latest two financial years including those performed during a multicompartmental knee replacement.

***For Hip and Knee recorded activity in the CLR:***

- There is a new table showing dual consultant operating cases. This provides consultants with an indication of how many dual consultant operating cases they carry out and how many trainee-led operations they assist at.

***For Hip and Knee joints in the CLR:***

- There is a new appendix report showing Standardised Mortality Ratio where the CIC was recorded as Lead Surgeon on the procedure.

***For Hip and Knee joints in the SLR:***

- There is a new appendix report showing Standardised Mortality Ratio where the surgeon was recorded as Lead Surgeon on the procedure.

***For all joints in the CLR and SLR:***

- There is a new appendix report containing all tables which show patient identifiable information. This is the first time this information is available for Ankle, Elbow and Shoulder surgeons.
